

# 2006 IMPACT SUMMARY



One of Taproot Foundation's core values is Make the Right Impact. To that end, over the past year we surveyed the nonprofit recipients of Taproot Foundation pro bono services who had projects completed in our 2006 fiscal year. We asked these organizations if we are achieving our mission of strengthening nonprofits and if they are satisfied with the experience. Out of 90 surveys distributed, we received 64 responses (71%).



## **The Taproot Foundation is a valuable resource to the sector.**

97% of nonprofits reported that they would recommend the Taproot Foundation to other nonprofit organizations. These projects represent an estimated \$3 million in capacity building services that the nonprofits could not have otherwise afforded.



## **We are achieving our mission of strengthening nonprofit organizations.**

100% of nonprofits agreed that their infrastructure had been strengthened as a result of their pro bono project, including 47% that strongly agreed. Many nonprofits cited unexpected benefits, including 67% stating that the project had significantly increased management and governance capabilities.



## **Our clients are satisfied with their experience with the Taproot Foundation.**

93% of nonprofits were satisfied with the final deliverable of their project, including 62% that were very satisfied. The volunteer teams that we recruited and managed received a 95% satisfaction approval. 30% of nonprofits, however, did report that using volunteers for capacity building projects made the timeline too long.
